**What:** *Petroglyphs – Signs of Life (Return Season – Adelaide)*

This mesmerising collaboration between South Australian contemporary dance company, Leigh Warren & Dancers and indigenous choreographer, Gina Rings explores some of the unique elements of the Australian landscape, language and people through the oldest form of visual communication, petroglyphs.

After its successful premiere season in 2005, *Petroglyphs - Signs of Life* returns to the stunning gallery space at Tandanya for an encore season.

This landmark production received rave reviews in 2005 and saw choreographers Leigh Warren and Gina Rings pick up the 2005 Adelaide Critics Circle Innovation Award.

Performed by indigenous and non-indigenous dancers, together with singers from the central desert, in a space transformed by spectacular artworks, *Petroglyphs - Signs of Life* brings together dance performances, music, sound composition and visual art.
